The Building Trades Contract allows Craftsworkers to elect an additional 40 or 80 hours of vacation. If the additional vacation hours are elected they are issued at a lower adjusted prevailing state rate. The additional 40 or 80 hours are prorated based on the Full Time Equivalent.

If an employee elects the additional 40 or 80 hours annual leave, this will result in a reduced prevailing rate. This will effect an employee's Income Continuation insurance, the amount of State Group Life Insurance, as well as the final average earnings for computing a retirement benefit, as well as and the value of a sick leave account upon retirement.

Employees who wish to elect this option for the upcoming calendar year must submit their request in writing prior to January 1. Employees who do not elect an option will retain their current vacation option.
